HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS MONTH

Human trafficking is **a crime that is hidden in plain sight**. The trafficking of humans includes forced labor, sexual slavery, forced marriage and the harvesting of organs and tissues. Our communities border the 101 corridor which is high in human trafficking, especially in motels and hotels. Be aware of the warning signs. Please help us save them. Some indications that a person may be a victim of human trafficking include:

- Malnourished
- Signs of physical injuries and abuse
- Avoiding eye contact with other people and authority figures, such as law Enforcement
- A scripted response to your questions
- No personal possessions
- Checking into hotels or motels with older males
- Poor physical or dental health
- Tattoo branding on the neck and or lower back
- Security that appear to keep people inside, such as barbed wire on a fence or bars covering the insides of windows
- Not allowing people to go out in public alone, or speak for themselves

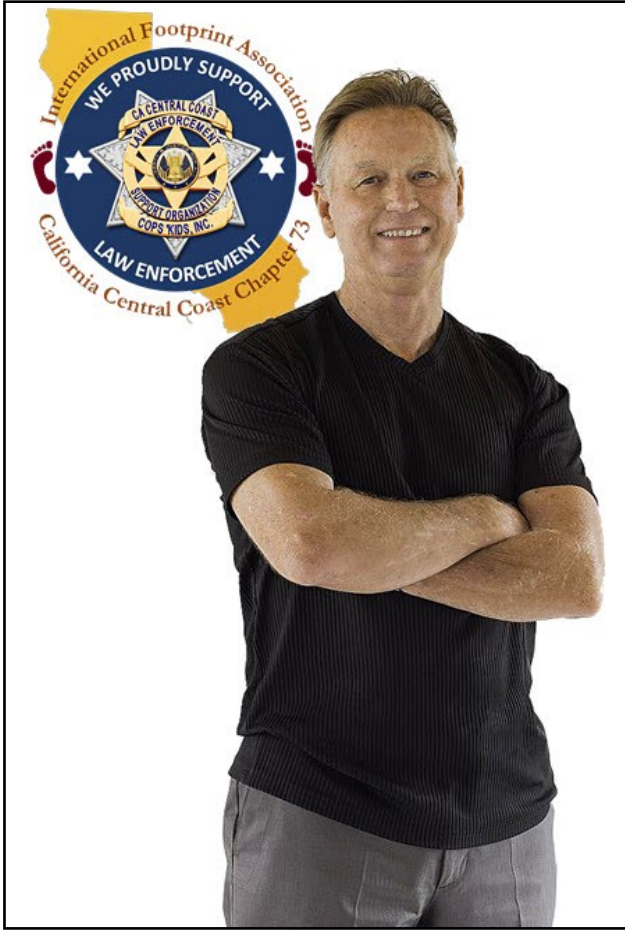


30th Anniversary of the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff's Office Christmas Bike Giveaway

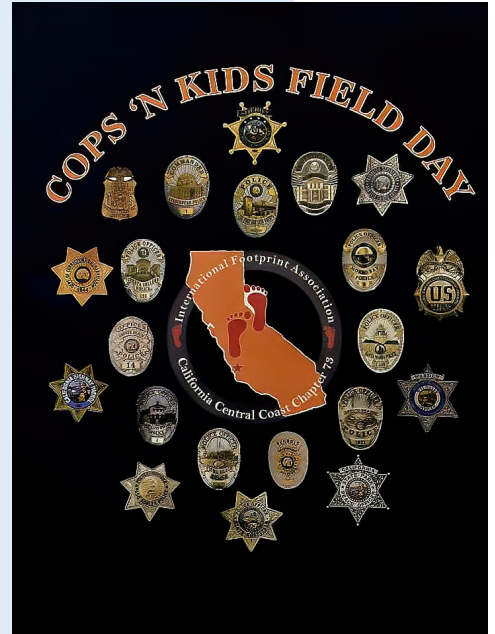

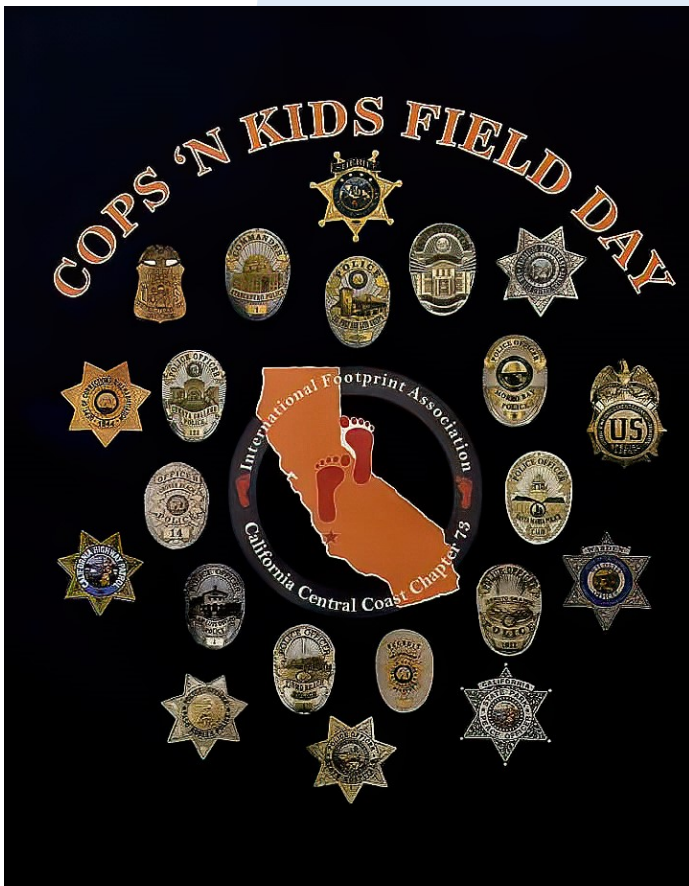
Show your Support for Law Enforcement

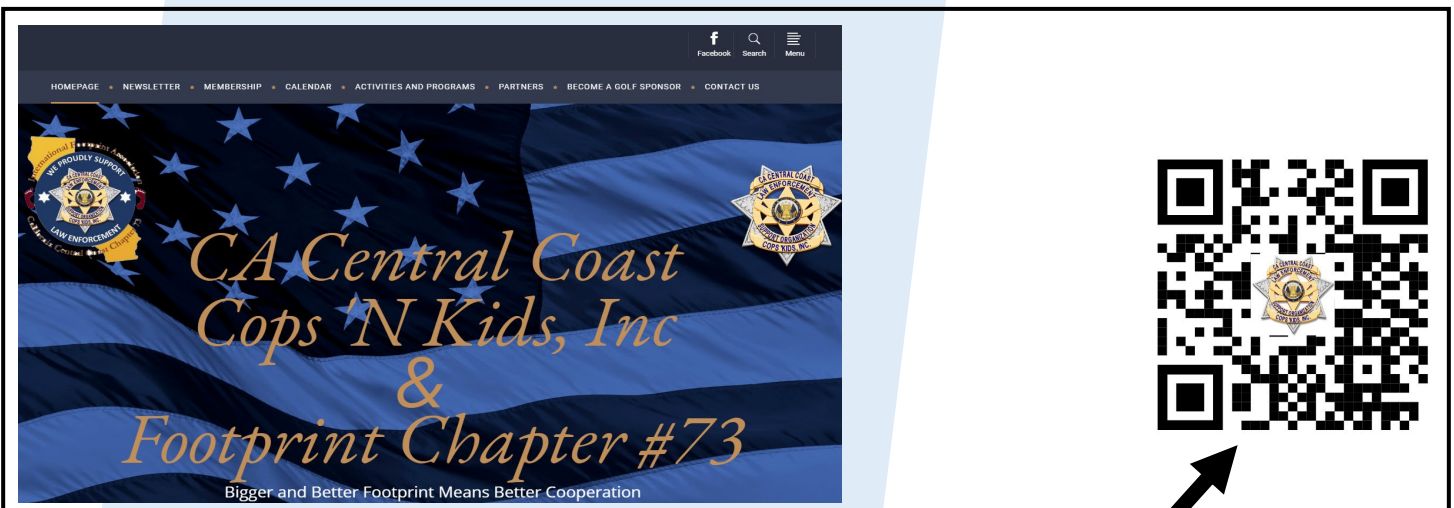
